ORDER

- 1. Order Respondent to pay Applicant the sum of \$5,812.00 and interest of \$134.87.
- 2. No order as to costs.

REASONS

- 1. The Applicant in this matter is claiming \$5,812.00 for water damage to areas of his house which he owns with his wife.
- 2. That damage followed a significant storm occurring on 2 February 2005.
- 3. I accept that the Applicant's house was damaged in the areas which he gave evidence about.
- 4. I heard affirmed evidence from the Assessor for the Applicant that the cost of repairs equals \$4,950.00 and that there was an electrical cost incurred of \$728.20. There is also a claim for the excess of \$200.00. These amount to \$5,878.00. The amount of the claim, however, is \$5,812.00.
- 5. I accept the evidence of the Applicant and the Assessor.
- 6. On the basis of their evidence (as depicted in the photographs) I am satisfied that the flashing works on the roof allowed water to enter the premises (on a date shortly after the completed construction of the house). I am satisfied such flashing works were not done to the appropriate standard. I accept the Assessor's evidence in that regard in particular. He impressed me as a very experienced person and one well-qualified to express his views.

- 7. I listened carefully to the evidence of the Respondent but it did not detract in any way from that of the Applicant or his witness.
- 8. I would make it clear that I have no evidence before me which would suggest the Respondent was not otherwise a builder of good repute.
- 9. I find for the Applicant in the sum of \$5,812.00. I do not allow above that amount.
- 10. I disallow costs. The matter is under \$10,000.00.
- 11. I allow interest of \$134.87.
