Power in numbers-

VICTORIANS have the opportunity to slash their electricity and gas bills by 16 per cent through a revolutionary people power scheme invented by a former righthand man of ex-prime minister Kevin Rudd.

One Big Switch, previously operated only in NSW and Queensland, pushes utility companies down on price by switching customers en masse and securing huge group discounts.

More than 40,000 consumers have already signed

up to the free program, cofounded by Rudd spin doctor turned entrepreneur Lachlan Harris.

Now Victorian households have the chance to cash in on a 16 per cent discount on electricity and gas as part of a three-year contract with retailer Australian Power & Gas. The discount is given to One Big Switch members who swap from their current provider and pay bills on time.
